






<p><b><u>Literacy (Writing)</u></b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Draw a picture of your pet or pets. Can you write their names? If you don't have a pet, draw a picture of a pet you would like to have. Write a sentence about your pet, what they are good at and what they like to eat.</li><li>• Practise your handwriting using the video clips on the school website to help you</li></ul>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ask your friends and family what pets they have at home. Create a tally chart to represent how many of each animal there is. Which animal is the most popular pet?</li><li>• Practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and backwards in ones from 20</li></ul>	<p><b><u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u></b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Think about staying safe in, and near, water. You could make a water safety poster explaining how to keep safe</li></ul>
<p><b><u>Topic / Art</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Find a rock or a stone and create your very own 'rock pet'. You could paint it, stick things on it and make a little home for it too!</li></ul>	<p><b><u>Literacy (Reading)</u></b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read 'Hairy Maclary's Rumpus at the Vet' by Lynley Dodd or watch it being read (click on the link below) <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=31Y8Jswk1Zo">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=31Y8Jswk1Zo</a></li><li>• Talk about the pets in the story</li><li>• Practise reading the high frequency words and digraphs</li></ul>	<p><b><u>Physical Development</u></b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Go for a walk and when you get home draw a map of where you went and interesting things you saw on your journey</li></ul>
